The players, coaches, officials, and parents of the Flathead Lacrosse Club will follow the US Lacrosse Code of Conduct at all practices, games, tournaments, and events.

US LACROSSE CODE OF CONDUCT

Players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators are to conduct themselves in a manner that "Honors the Game" and demonstrates respect to other players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators fans. In becoming a member of the lacrosse community an individual assumes certain obligations and responsibilities to the game of lacrosse and its participants. The essential elements in this "Code of Conduct" are HONESTY and INTEGRITY. Those who conduct themselves in a manner that reflects these elements will bring credit to the sport of lacrosse, themselves, their team and their organization. It is only through such conduct that our sport can continue to earn and maintain a positive image and make its full contribution to amateur sports in the United States and around the world. US Lacrosse supports the following behaviors for those who participate in the sport or are involved in any way with US Lacrosse. The following essential elements of the "Code of Conduct" must be followed:

I will honor the history of the men's lacrosse and commit to the maintaining the core values of the game's culture.

I will recognize the value of safe and fair play by teaching, enforcing and playing by the letter and spirit of the men's game.

I will practice and encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other men's lacrosse event.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of our players ahead of any personal desire to win.

I will support coaches and officials working with players in order to encourage a safe, positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will do my very best to make the sport fun for every one who participates.

I will ask all family members and fans to be tolerant and inclusive by treating other players, coaches, fans and officials with high regard and respect.

Players that cannot abide by the Code of Conduct will face disciplinary actions determined by the coach. Players may be suspended from practices or games or face expulsion from the team.

We understand the importance of the code and agree with the expectations of playing for Flathead Lacrosse Club. As a player, I will work to honor the game and I will be certain to communicate with my coach any concerns or issues as they arise.
